

## Future of Logos 2

When we joined the Logos 2 in September, we thought the ministry of Logos 2 was ending in May after the celebration port. Because the **Logos Hope** - the next ship is not ready, the Logos 2 will be extending after May. We now expect to be on the Logos 2 for the rest of our two years commitment.

Although we are somewhat disappointed as the Logos Hope proposed to bring bigger opportunities, we know God has His hand over everything and we must trust in His timing and not ours. All these changes have led to uncertainty that has the potential to de-stabilise the crew here. Please pray that we would keep motivated and focused on God through all the changes.



## Logos Hope

At present Logos Hope is still in Malta awaiting a contract worth €12 Million to be signed before it can sail to a shipyard for major restructuring work. At present there is €9 Million available but we have been promised a large donation that will make up the extra needed in order to complete the work. Please pray that this donation will come in so that the ship can soon sail to Croatia for the work to be done.

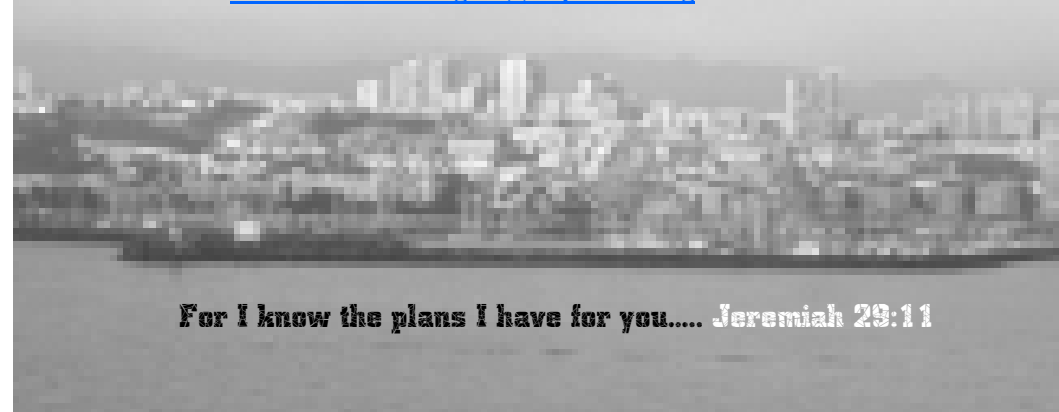

### Cameroon

In Cameroon (once we were allowed off the ship) were able to do a lot of ministry outside the ship. With the book-fair being much quieter in this port, teams from the book ex department were sent out 2 or 3 times a week. Being a driver, Steve was called on to go out quite a bit. Through translators we were able to do open airs and minister to children in an orphanage. Open airs in Cameroon are very different to in the UK!

Here we saw our busiest port yet, back in the Caribbean we had training for crowd control, and here we needed it! We also had a wonderful time fellowshiping with the volunteers onboard.



### Sierra Leone

With this being our last port in Africa, we were already thinking about our move to Europe. We spent some time as a team redesigning the book fair for Europe. Part of our redesign were some cabinets for a new children's area. Contacts were already made with an organization called Handicap international who have a carpenters and textile workshops. We gave them the work of making our cabinets and also some African style bags to sell in our book-fair.



### Ship Family

Did we forget to tell you we have a family. In fact we have 10 children!; Emily, Olivia, Gil, Roger, Neil, Weibke, Adele, Akin and John and Christine, who we actually call the grandparents! Everyone on the ship is in a family and we come together for special occasions such as this one on Steve's Birthday on the 6th February. We also meet once a month in our cabin for a prayer night. Also in Takoradi, Ghana our family lead a special prayer emphasis one morning on India.



### Prayer Night

Every Thursday we have prayer night onboard. This runs from 7:30-11:00pm. It is also a time when the current OM News is shared and we hear more about the prayer needs onboard. We often approach this evening with the wrong attitude, knowing that it will be a long time before we get to bed but every week we are amazed at the power of prayer and the wonderful gift that God has given in being able to communicate with Him.
