PST (pre-ship training) in Trinidad

On arrival to Trinidad on the 1st September, we were ferried away to a hotel for three weeks of intensive training, preparing us for life and ministry aboard the Logos 2. We learnt many things including; survival at sea, crowd management, first aid, safety onboard, evangelism techniques and drama. We also spent a lot of time studying God's word and developing relationships with the other 55 people joining the Logos. The highlight of the training was an overnight church team where we were involved in an open air, door-to-door work and the Sunday service.

One Monday, 20 of us went to maracas bay in the north of Trinidad. Even on our day off, God used members of our group to witness to a lady who then gave her life to Christ.

We have arrived

On the 21st September, we were finally allowed to join the ship and settle into our new lives. We are both working in the book exhibition department. Kathryn is working in the book hold where she, sorts, prices, unpacks and picks the orders for the day. She starts work at 5am and works through 'til 2pm. Steve is the manager of the deal bag room where donated textbooks are distributed to the public. Because he is responsible for the room, he works from 9am 'til 10pm although not all the time.

We both enjoy where we work and feel a part of the overall ministry of the ship. Every day there are queues of people, waiting to get on to get the books that they otherwise could not afford. Every person goes through a gospel presentation before they are allowed to shop. Last year alone over 1 million stepped onto one of the two ships. That is a lot of people reached for God.
